<b>16 ENTRY CANCELLATION</b>	<p>Cancellation of participation is possible till <b>February 15, 2020</b> at <b>12h</b> local time  After this deadline, the penalty for non show policy will apply, as well as the cancellation fee.</p> <p><b>Cancellations must be sent to the ITTF Competition Manager AND the Organisers</b></p> <p>For cancellations after the entry deadline (30 days before the event), a <b>cancellation fee of 150 Euro €</b> will be charged for <b>each player, coach and medical staff</b>. (Coach &amp; Medical staff needs to pay only in case they booked the official Hotel package).  These cancellation amounts will be added to the associations' invoice to be paid, together with the hospitality costs, to the organizers either by bank transfer or by cash on site.</p> <p><b>For seeded players a fee of US\$ 2000, unless a medical certificate is submitted, and the player does not compete in other events during the event. In case a medical certificate is submitted and approved by the ITTF the normal cancellation as for non-seeded players will apply. The ITTF will confirm to the LOC the cancellation fee to be charged in these cases.</b></p> <p><b>Associations will not be allowed to enter future WORLD TOUR and CHALLENGE events if any cancellation fees remain outstanding.</b></p>

<b>19 VISA</b>	<p>For those who would need a visa to enter into the country, please contact the organizers to get a letter of invitation at least 50 days in advance with: Full name, nationality, passport number with expiration date, address and occupation and also birthday and place of birth.</p>
<b>20 INFORMATION FOR PLAYERS</b>	<p>By entering the event, all players and other participants in general agree to abide by all ITTF rules, policies (including signing the Conditions of Participation form) and by the rules and regulations of the Organizing Committee. All entered associations, pairs and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the ITTF and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet web casting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition.</p> <p>Doping control may be conducted in accordance with the relevant World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) International Standards and ITTF Anti-Doping Rules.</p> <p>See the anti-doping section of the ITTF.com <a href="https://www.ittf.com/anti-doping/">https://www.ittf.com/anti-doping/</a> for more details, including the list of prohibited substances and methods in force, doping control and, if applicable, the Therapeutic Use Exemption processes.</p>
<b>21 INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS</b>	<p>In the context of betting participants shall not, by any manner whatsoever, infringe the principle of fair play, show unsporting conduct, or attempt to influence the course or result of a competition, or any part thereof, in a manner contrary to sporting ethics. Any violation of this principle shall be disciplined according to provisions of ITTF regulation 3.5.3.</p>
<b>22 INSURANCE</b>	<p>By entering the event, each association must ensure that all delegation members have medical, travel and other appropriate insurance.</p>
<b>23 NUMBER OF ENTRIES PER ASSOCIATION</b>	<p>According to the 2020 ITTF World Tour Directives we have to limit the number of entries to <b>390</b> players in total.</p> <p>Only the final entries are taken into consideration by the ITTF Competition Manager and Organizers. Full details about entries' numbers can be found in the 2020 WT Directives but in general for the ITTF World Tour a National Association can enter an indicative number of entries as follows:</p> <p><b>Singles:</b> Each National Association can enter players as may deemed necessary, but the ITTF reserves the right to approve less entries than the indicative 6 per National Association and 12 for the host association per gender, in case of very high number of entries. In these cases, a number will be guaranteed per National Association and all remaining positions will be filled by WR. In cases of oversubscription, players from each National Association will be approved by WR. For each NA all players in seeded positions will be approved automatically, with the maximum number per NA applying, and remaining positions per NA will be filled as well by WR.</p> <p><b>Men and Women Doubles:</b> Maximum 2 pairs of 4 players per National Association and maximum 3 pairs or 6 players for the Host Association (2 pairs regardless if they are in the Top 24/40 pairs or not and the third pair only if it is included in the Top 24/40 pairs by WR).</p> <p><b>Mixed Doubles:</b> Maximum 2 pairs or 4 players per National Association (including the Host Association). Only pairs from the same National Olympic Committee are allowed with the exceptions mentioned in point 2.2c of the 2020 WT Directives. 1 pair or 2 players per National Association will be first approved provided they are in the Top 40 pairs entered and an additional pair will only be approved if spots are available.</p> <p>For all doubles the selection is otherwise done according to the Doubles Ranking. Only the Top pairs up to the maximum numbers indicated on the 2020 WT Directives and the maximum numbers per National Association as described above will be approved. Entries in singles and doubles will be approved based on the final number of entries and excess entries will be put on Waiting List.</p> <p>Please refer to the 2020 WT Directives and other Official Documents on the World Tour section of the ITTF.com or contact the Competition Manager.</p>
