In order to secure full participation, National Associations failing to confirm their participation according to deadlines will be removed from the list of participants and replaced by another Association.

If a confirmed team fails to arrive in Korat, its place will not be replaced by another team. NO REPLACEMENTS WILL BE DONE AFTER THE DRAW IS MADE.

Coaches/Officials/Accompanying Persons

According to the ITTF policy for World Junior Table Tennis Championships, the number of persons that can join the teams in the "Official Party" is limited as follows:

For an Association with 2 teams participating, the maximum is:

- 8 Athletes (4 boys and 4 girls)
- 2 Coaches
- 3 Delegation members

For Associations with one or no team participating and from 5 to 8 players in total participating in the individual events, the maximum is:

- 8 Athletes (4 boys and 4 girls up to the limit of qualified/selected players)
- 2 Coaches
- 2 Delegation members

For Associations with 1 to 4 players participating, the maximum is:

- 4 Athletes (up to the limit of qualified/selected players)
- 1 coach for each 3 players participating (maximum 2 coaches)
- 2 Delegation members

All other persons wishing to accompany the teams are subject to special charges, as mentioned above if they wish to use the "accompanying person's hospitality packages". These packages are limited and subject to availability of places in the official hotels. Priority will be given to the Official Party of all the delegations.

12. PLAYING SYSTEM

The teams and the singles events will be played in two stages:

Stage 1: Round-robin group matches; followed by

Stage 2: Knockout main draw

The doubles and mixed doubles events will be played on a knockout basis.

13. QUALIFIED TEAMS / PLAYERS

Qualified through the 2019 ITTF U18 Continental events and the November 2019 U18 ITTF World Rankings. List published on the event page.

14. EVENTS SEEDING

Seeding for all the events will be done according to the November 2019 ITTF U18 Singles World Rankings and special seeding will be applied according to rule 8.7 of the ITTF World Ranking Regulations. For more details, please check the "Important Information – Events Seeding" document, published on the event page.

15. TEAM MANAGERS MEETING

The team managers meeting will be held on 23th November (local/time to be announced later).

16. DRAWS

The draws for the Team Events will be performed on 22nd November (local/time to be announced later).

For the Singles (First Stage) and Doubles Events the draws will be performed on 25th November (local/time to be announced later).

17. ENTRY FEES

The entry fees shall be USD 50 for each entry in a team event, USD 30 for each pair in a doubles event and USD 15 for each entry in a singles event.

These entry fees have to be submitted together with the accommodation fees and paid in USD \$ to the LOC.

19. TRANSPORTATION

LOC will provide transportation to the participants from and to **Bangkok International Airport (BKK – Suvarnabhumi)** free of charge.

20. HOSPITALITY

Hospitality will be provided by the LOC to all entitled to free hospitality from lunch on the 22nd November to breakfast on the 2nd December 2019.

- An association qualifying with a team, comprising four (4) athletes & one (1) coach, is entitled to free hospitality for a maximum of three (3) persons (double occupancy basis). If less than four (4) athletes are nominated the association is entitled to free hospitality for two (2) persons only.
- An association qualifying with two teams comprising eight (8) athletes & two (2) coaches is entitled to free hospitality for a maximum of five (5) persons (double occupancy basis). If less than eight (8) athletes are entering the association is entitled to free hospitality for four (4) persons only.
- Athletes qualified to participate in the Individual events only: no free hospitality.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Due to the distance between Korat and the official airport (Bangkok), in case a team arrives in Bangkok on the 22nd November, the LOC offers complimentary full board accommodation for one night in Bangkok (The Grand Four Wings Convention Hotel*****) for all the Official Party persons. These participants will be transferred to Korat on 23rd November, 08:00 AM.

If a team chooses direct transport from Bangkok airport to Korat on the 22nd November, only the entitled persons (point 22. Hospitality) will have free hospitality.

- The Association may choose to stay in Korat or in Bangkok (the night of 22nd November) and should inform the LOC (wjttc2019@gmail.com) **before 17th October**.

Rates for extra persons and those not entitled to free hospitality

The LOC will charge a daily rate **per person of the official party: USD \$160 in** single occupancy or **USD \$120** in double occupancy, including breakfast, lunch, dinner, accreditation and local transport. The rates will be available for a fixed number of extra persons.

The Official Party is entitled up to 13 persons if the Association meets the requirements expressed in this Prospectus.

Additional persons to those allowed below may get the "accompanying person's package" with the rate **per person: USD \$160** in single occupancy or **USD \$120** in double occupancy **BASED ON AVAILABILITY.**

All entries including officials and accompanying persons should be submitted through the **ITTF Online Entry System for Junior Events** : <http://wjentries.ittf.link>

The deadline to submit the travel/accommodation details is 17th October 2019

21. CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellation policy applies as follows:

- Cancellations before 3rd November: No cancellation fee
- Cancellations between 4th and 13th November: Flat fee of USD 160 / person for each person not entitled to free hospitality
- Cancellations on or after 14th November: Flat fee of USD 350 / person for each person not entitled to free hospitality

The maximum tolerated number of cancellations can't exceed 10% of the overall.

22. OBLIGATIONS

All players nominated are willing to compete against any other participating player and accept to be under ITTF Anti-doping, Racket control and Anti-harassment policies and procedures during the Championships. The entry forms will contain a statement about the above points to be signed by a responsible official of the nominating Association and no entry form will be accepted unless such an undertaking has been given.

23. DOPING CONTROL

Doping tests will be conducted during the event in accordance with ITTF anti-doping rules. Please check [here](#). Note that all the players under 18 years of age called for testing must be accompanied by a representative of their delegation older than 18 years old acting in loco parentis.

24. RACKET CONTROL

Racket controls will be conducted during the event in accordance with latest ITTF regulations.

25. TELEVISION, MOTION PICTURE AND INTERNET COVERAGE CONDITIONS

By entering the Championships, participants agree to abide by all ITTF rules and by the rules and regulations of the LOC. All entered associations, teams and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the ITTF and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet web casting, motion picture coverage and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage and photographic coverage of any kind; and hence accept such coverage during the WJTTC. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition. Any participant, when called upon, must appear promptly to press conferences or medal presentations and follow the procedures set by the ITTF and the LOC.

26. PAYMENTS

Provided that a pre-payment may be requested upon reservation, Associations are requested to pay their entry fees, extra hospitality costs and hospitality costs for those persons not entitled to free accommodation and meals **by bank transfer**. Associations that need to pay in advance by bank transfer are requested to notify the LOC, which will provide with the bank details for the electronic transfer. Payment by electronic Bank Transfer should be completed **before 24 October 2019** to the bank account specified in the invoice received from the LOC.

Transfer has to be made so that the net amount is received on the LOC's Bank Account.
