THE INTERNATIONAL TABLE TENNIS FEDERATION (ITTF)

ITTF is the international governing body of the sport, responsible for the management, regulation and growth of table tennis and Para table tennis.

Today, the ITTF governs a remarkable 227 affiliated member associations, the most of any International Sports Federation. This extensive network reflects the ITTF's unwavering commitment to its vision: "Table Tennis. For All. For Life." This vision extends beyond the professional level, actively promoting inclusivity and accessibility for players of all ages and abilities.

Para table tennis has been part of the Paralympic programme since the first Games were held in Rome in 1960, when only wheelchair athletes competed. Interestingly, Para table tennis has a much longer history in the Paralympic Games than table tennis, which debuted at the Olympic Games at Seoul in 1988.

The ITTF also oversees the prestigious World Para Table Tennis Championships, held since 1990. Leading the ITTF is the current President, Petra SÖRLING (SWE), elected in 2021. Under her guidance, the ITTF continues to drive table tennis' and Para table tennis' global development.

The upcoming Paris 2024 Paralympics represent the ultimate stage for Para table tennis athletes. The ITTF plays a vital role in identifying and cultivating these talents, ensuring outstanding performances.





ITTF FOUNDATION

The ITTF Foundation is an international non-profit organisation, focusing specifically on table tennis. Following its inauguration in 2019, there has been continued growth of the CSR pillars which originated within the ITTF Development Programme.

Since its creation, the ITTF Foundation has been an independent organisation, and is the official CSR arm of the ITTF Group, promoting Table Tennis for Development and Peace around the world. Under the tagline 'Solidarity through Table Tennis' the ITTF Foundation aims to engage people worldwide, initiate or support projects to empower individuals, foster positive social change and make table tennis and Para table tennis popular, universal, and inclusive.



Para table tennis is the third largest Paralympic sport in terms of athlete numbers, with more than 40 million competitive players in over 100 member associations worldwide.

From 29 August to 7 September, the Para table tennis events at the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games will be held at the South Paris Arena 4. In total, 280 players will give their all to win precious medals in one of the 31 medal events.

The draws for the Doubles events are scheduled for 26 August at 17:00 in the Briefing Room of South Paris Arena 4. The Singles events draws will follow on 30 August at 15:30, also in the same location. The draws will be available [here](#).

A match is contested over the best of five sets, with each set won by the first player to reach 11 points with a two-point margin.

This sport is played by athletes with a wide range of impairments, who are placed into 11 classes – 1 to 5 are players competing in a wheelchair, 6 to 10 are players competing standing, and 11 is for players with an intellectual impairment.

For doubles (MD4, MD8, MD14, MD18, WD5, WD10, WD14, WD20, XD7, XD17), the number indicates the sum of the handicaps of each player, which must not be exceeded. For example, MD4 can combine two class 1 players, two class 2 players, one class 1 and one class 2 player or one class 1 and one class 3 player.

Para table tennis follows the exact same rules as its Olympic counterpart, with slight modifications regarding the service rules for players competing in wheelchairs for which backspin is forbidden (the ball returns towards the net), as is the use of the short sides of the table. In doubles, as in tennis doubles, wheelchair players are not obliged to take turns playing the ball. They are also allowed to adapt their grip on the racket. Players with gripping difficulties can use an orthosis to fix the racket to their hand or use a strap if they cannot hold the handle on their own. For some standing players, the use of a cane or crutch may be permitted under the rules, particularly in classes 6 to 8.

Class 1 - Wheelchair Athletes

These players have no sitting balance and a severely affected playing arm due to a spinal-cord lesion or polio.
