## 7. Events

### Team Events

1. Men's Team
2. Women's Team

One men's team and one women's team will qualify for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games.





## 8. Eligibility

Qualification is open to all athletes selected by their ITTF-Oceania National Association and approved by their National Olympic Committee to take part in the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games. To be eligible to participate all athletes must:

- Comply with the rules of the ITTF as they appear in the latest ITTF Handbook (4.5.1.1),
- Comply with the eligibility criteria established by the ITTF for Olympic competitions (4.5.1.3).

## 9. Format of Play

### Team Events

Associations may enter one Men's Team and one Women's Team, with a maximum of 5 players. Each team match will comprise of 3 players, using the Olympic Playing format as follows:

- 1) doubles B & C v Y & Z
- 2) A v X
- 3) C v Z
- 4) A v Y
- 5) B v X

If there are four or fewer teams entered a single round robin will be played, if more than 4 teams are entered a direct knockout will be played, with both a final and a third-place playoff.

## 10. Seeding & Draws

The Olympic Team Ranking (OTR) December 2019 will be used for seeding purposes.

The draws for the team events will take place on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> December, Mornington Peninsula Table Tennis Association Stadium club room after the Managers Meeting.

## 13. Hospitality

## 14. Travel and Health Insurance

All participants (athletes, coaches, accompanying persons) are required to have their own travel and health insurance.

## 15. Visa Requirements

For those countries requiring a visa to enter Australia, the Local Organising Committee will help with the application process to assist in ensuring the visa is approved on time. Participants must ensure they have received their Australian Visa prior to their departure for Australia. ## 16. Obligations

All athletes entered must compete against any other participating athlete and by entering; agree to be bound by the ITTF Anti-Doping, Anti-Harassment, Classification, Illegal Betting and Corruption policies and procedures during the event. The entry forms contain an undertaking to be signed by a responsible official of the nominating association and the team member covering these matters and no entry will be accept unless such an undertaking has been given.

## 17. TV, Motion Picture & Internet Coverage Conditions

By entering the event, athletes agree to abide by all ITTF Rules and by the rules and regulations of the Organising Committee. All entered associations and individual athletes agree to be under the auspices of ITTF and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet web casting, motion picture coverage and photographic coverage of any kind.





Participants release all rights or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage and photographic coverage of any kind. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition.

## 18. Betting

In the context of betting, participants shall not, by any manner whatsoever infringe the principle of fair play, show unsporting conduct or attempt to influence the course or result of a competition or any part thereof in a manner contrary to sporting ethics. Any violation of this principle shall be disciplined according to provisions of the ITTF Regulations in the ITTF handbook under sections: 3.5.3, 6.9.2.1 and 6.9.7.3.

## 19. Medical Services

A first aid medical service will be provided. In addition, access to a medical service for serious injuries or illness will be available and all participants should know the name and location of the person to refer to in case of a medical emergency.

## 20. Doping

Doping tests may be conducted during the event in accordance with ITTF anti-doping rules. Please refer to Section 5: ITTF Anti-Doping Rules of the ITTF Handbook: <https://www.ittf.com/wp-content/uploads/2019/04/2019ITTFHandbook.pdf>

Please note that for athletes under the age of 18 years, a parent or guardian must accompany them during the testing process. The parent or guardian must be over the age of 18 years.

Should any athletes require a therapeutic exemption, this should be registered with the ITTF at least 30 days prior to the event.





## 21. Promotional Activities

Athletes are expected to attend the following promotional activities:

- Opening Ceremony (if applicable)
- Media interviews
- Award Ceremonies (in full tracksuit and sport shoes).
